A team consists of four riders. The riders in each team jump in succession. All teams jump 2 rounds. Best 3 scores in each round to count. If, after the second round there is a tie for FIRST place there will be a jump off against the clock - each team will nominate one rider to represent them.

Only teams placed 1st need to be mounted for prize giving. All other teams to be unmounted but correctly turned out.

Prizes - 1st Place £60. Rosettes to 6th. place.

Entries close 22nd December or before if classes are full.
Times will be put on Facebook and ADRC website on 28th December.

Entries £60 per team (£15 per person)

Times are intended as a guide and riders may be asked to go earlier in the event of withdrawals but every effort will be made to run on time.

Fancy Dress is optional and always welcome. Hot and cold refreshments will be available through the day.

RULES

1. Hats to the current BRC standard (PAS 015 (1998 or 2011), VG1 01.040 (2014-12, with appropriate kite mark, ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) SNELL E2001 or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) must be worn. Hats must be correctly secured, by all riders whether competitors or not. Show/Tweed Jacket, with shirt and tie or a stock. If in fancy dress, you **MUST** have long sleeves and appropriate Jodhpur/Riding boots. **BODY PROTECTORS recommended.**
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the **HEALTH & SAFETY** of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials or stewards. Entries are made entirely at your own risk. No liability can be accepted for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders or any other person or property howsoever caused.
3. The organisers and committee reserve the right to alter or cancel any class at their discretion.
4. The judge's decision is final.
5. Objections in writing may be lodged up to 15 minutes after the finish of the class, or 15 minutes after the incident giving cause for the objection, with a deposit of £20, which will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
6. To be run in accordance with BRC & BS rules. 7. No entry fees will be refunded after the entries closing date.

A team consists of four riders. The riders in each team jump in succession. All teams jump two rounds, the best 3 scores in each round to count. If, after the second round, there is equality for **FIRST PLACE**, there will be a jump off against the clock - in which case the teams concerned will nominate 1 rider to participate in the jump off on behalf of the whole team. The second round is timed and these times are used to determine lower places, if faults alone cannot do this.

Prize giving: Only the teams that have jumped off for first place need to be mounted for the prize giving – all other teams to go into the ring un-mounted but **correctly turned out**. In the event that there is an outright winner then that is the only team that will be required to be mounted.

Times will be published on the website after 8pm 28th Dec. These are a guideline **ONLY**. If teams withdraw you will be expected to run earlier. Please arrive with plenty of time. www.ackworthridingclub.co.uk
